The non spending of grants also cause a major impact for the 3rd quarter performance. In terms of the WSIG grant, the Department of Water delayed in transferring funds to the municipality, which in turn delayed the municipality to commit. the Announcement of the lockdown by the president during the month of

march, also played a role in the municipality not fullfilling its mandates as set out in the IDP and SDBIP. The programmes affected by lockdown was approval of the draft IDP and budget, Mayoral IMBIZO, IDP REP forums and approval of thr Oversight report by council. The above mentioned programmes were later rescheduled for the 4th quarter.
