The **54** % under performance was due to low revenue collection which is caused by local municipalities not transferring money for water services. The non implementation of resolutions by directorates in terms of Risk mitigations, Audit committe resolutions and Internal audit issues. Discliplinary cases that are not finalised due to COVID 19. LED strategy & GIS atrategy not developed

during 2019/20 financial year. Bids advertised not placed on the CIDB website. Municipal Tribunal not appointed throughout the year, which halted developement for the Locals in the Mopani District Municipality. The non spending of grants also cause a major impact for the Quarter under review, the MIG, WSIG,RRAMS,RBIG were not fully spend by year end (30 June 2020). In terms of the WSIG grant, the Department of Water delayed in transferring funds to the municipality, which in turn delayed the municipality to commit. The Oversight report by MPAC could not be tabled in the 4th quarter due to public hearing not conducted, the probinng could not take place due to COVID 19 restrictions. Public hearing has since been conducted on the 23 July 2020.
