	1. Structure Height & Dimensions			
	• Each giraffe structure shall have a minimum height of 2.5 metres, with proportional width and depth ensuring visual balance and structural stability.			
	2. Material & Construction			
	• The structure must be fabricated from high-grade mild steel (minimum S355 or equivalent) with corrosion-resistant properties suitable for long-term outdoor installation.			
	3. Structural Integrity & Safety			
1	 All units must be engineered for wind loads typical to Mopani District and comply with SANS design standards, ensuring safe public installation in outdoor environments. 	5 Units		

4. Surface Treatment & Finish

 Steel must be hot-dip galvanized, primed, and finished with weather-resistant outdoor paint or powder-coating to prevent rust, fading, or degradation.

5. Artistic Design Requirements

 The giraffe must reflect an aesthetic, tourismfriendly design, capturing realistic or stylized African wildlife imagery consistent across all five units.

6. Lighting Integration (Christmas Lights)

Each structure must be pre-wired with energyefficient LED Christmas lights (minimum IP65
outdoor rating) in warm white or multicolour
options, with evenly distributed illumination
along the body, neck, and legs.

7. Electrical Compliance

 Lighting and wiring must comply with SANS electrical safety standards, including waterproof connectors, outdoor cabling, and a secure power supply interface for municipal electrical teams.

8. Mounting & Installation Method

 Each structure must include a secure mounting base or anchoring system (e.g., steel baseplate with anchor bolts or ground stakes) suitable for municipal-designated public spots.

9. Portability & Maintenance Considerations

 Design must allow easy transportation, assembly/disassembly, and access for maintenance of lights, with durable components to ensure multi-year festive use.

10. Delivery, Installation & Handover Requirements

•	Supplier must deliver, install, test, and commission all five structures at the identified locations in the five local municipalities, and provide a two months warranty on workmanship, materials, and lighting systems

CERTIFICATE OF INDEPENDENT BID DETERMINATION

- This Municipal Bidding Document (MBD) must form part of all bids¹ invited.
- Section 4 (1) (b) (iii) of the Competition Act No. 89 of 1998, as amended, prohibits an agreement between, or concerted practice by, firms, or a decision by an association of firms, if it is between parties in a horizontal relationship and if it involves collusive bidding (or bid rigging). - 7. In particular, without limiting the generality of paragraphs 6 above, there has been no consultation, communication, agreement or arrangement with any competitor regarding:
- (a) Prices;
- (b) Geographical area where product or service will be rendered (market allocation)
- (c) Methods, factors or formulas used to calculate prices;
- (d) The intention or decision to submit or not to submit, a bid;
- (e) The submission of a bid which does not meet the specifications and conditions of the bid; or
- (f) Bidding with the intention not to win the bid.
- 8. In addition, there have been no consultations, communications, agreements or arrangements with any competitor regarding the quality, quantity, specifications and conditions or delivery particulars of the products or services to which this bid invitation relates.
- 9. The terms of the accompanying bid have not been, and will not be, disclosed by the bidder, directly or indirectly, to any competitor, prior to the date and time of the official bid opening or of the awarding of the contract.
- ³ Joint venture or Consortium means an association of persons for the purpose of combining their expertise, property, capital, efforts, skill and knowledge in an activity for the execution of a contract.
- 10. I am aware that, in addition and without prejudice to any other remedy provided to combat any restrictive practices related to bids and contracts, bids that are suspicious will be reported to the Competition Commission for investigation and possible imposition of administrative penalties in terms of section 59 of the Competition Act No 89 of 1998 and or may be reported to the National Prosecuting Authority (NPA) for criminal investigation and or may be restricted from conducting business with the public sector for a period not exceeding ten (10) years in terms of the Prevention and Combating of Corrupt Activities Act No 12 of 2004 or any other applicable legislation.
