## INVITATION TO BID BID NUMBER: MDM 2011-25B

### PHALABORWA SEWEGE PUMP STATION: CIVIL WORK FOR PUMP STATION AND EMERGENCY POND

Bids are hereby invited for the construction of civil works for the Phalaborwa sewage pump station in the Limpopo Province. The station pumps the town of Phalaborwa's sewage to the wastewater treatment works approximately 5km outside of town.

This contract comprises the construction of the following civil work:

- A concrete lined emergency storage pond (1500 m<sup>3</sup>) for the sewage pump station.
- A 450 uPVC overflow pipeline (120m long) from the pump station to the emergency storage ponds.
- A 110 uPVC return pipeline (80m long) from the storage ponds to the pump station.
- Associated valve chambers.

Only bidders who are registered with the **CIDB** and have a grading of **4CE/3CEPE** or higher are eligible to bid for this contract.

Bid documents will be obtainable as from the **03<sup>rd</sup> March 2011** at the offices of Mopani District Municipality, Office No: 42, 1<sup>st</sup> Floor, Main Road, Giyani upon payment of non-refundable amount **R300.00** cash.

A Compulsory Site Inspection will be conducted at **11h00** on the **04<sup>th</sup> March 2011**. Prospective bidders are expected to meet the Engineer at the pump station in Phalaborwa. Access to the site can be obtained by travelling east into Phalaborwa using the R71 from Gravelotte (Hendrik van Eck Street). Go through the town of Phalaborwa and turn right into Koper Street at the SPAR complex. The site is situated immediately on your left behind SPAR.

Completed bids and supporting documents must be sealed in a cover clearly marked "**BID NO. MDM 2011-25B: PHALABORWA SEWEGE PUMP STATION: CIVIL WORK FOR PUMP STATION AND EMERGENCY POND**" and should be deposit in the bid box of Mopani District Municipality, Office No.42, 1st floor, Old Government building, Giyani, before **12h00** on the **25<sup>th</sup> March 2011** where bids will be opened in public.

Mopani District Municipality does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any bids and reserves the right to accept the whole or part of a bid. Bids will be evaluated and adjudicated in line with Mopani District Municipality's Procurement Policy in consultation to the CIDB Act and the 90/10 points system will be used. All bids will remain valid for a period of ninety days after the time and date of opening
