Bids are hereby invited from contractors for **UPGRADING OF SENWAMOKGOPE SEWAGE PLANT (PHASE 2)**

Only bidders who are registered with CIDB and have a grading of **CIDB 6 CE or 5CEPE** or higher are hereby eligible to bid for this contract.

Bids documents will be obtainable as from the **25TH January 2013**, from the offices of Mopani district Municipality Office 42, 1st floor, Mopani District Municipal Buildings, Giyani upon a payment of non-refundable cost of **R350.00** per document. Only cash or Bank guaranteed cheques payable directed to Mopani Municipality will be accepted.

A compulsory site inspection will be held on Wednesday the **30th January 2013** at **10h00**. Bidders are expected to meet a representative of the employer and engineer at Senwamokgope Sewage Plant (at the former Sekgosese College of Education, Senwamokgope Township).

All bids and supporting documents must be sealed in a cover clearly marked "**MDM 2013 - 029: UPGRADING OF SENWAMOKGOPE SEWAGE PLANT (PHASE 2)**" and must be deposited in the Bid box at Mopani District Municipality Office 42, 1st Floor, Mopani District Municipality Building, in Giyani, not later than Friday the **15th February 2013** at **12h00**, where bids will be opened in public.

Mopani District Municipality does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any bid and reserves the right to accept the whole or part of a bid. Bids will be evaluated and adjudicated in line with Mopani District Municipality's Procurement Policy in consultation to the CIDB Act and the 90/10 points system will be used. Bidders will be evaluation on Responsiveness of bids, Functionality and only bidders who meet the minimum requirement on functionality will be evaluated on Price and B-BBEE Status as indicated on the bid document

The Expanded Public Works Programme (EPWP) principles and guidelines on labour Intensive Construction methods will be applicable to this bid. Proof of certification for the implementation of labour intensive construction projects for management and supervisors staff would be an added advantage.
